-The fixings supplied are for solid walls. For hollow or stud walls use specialist fixings. -Before drilling ensure that there are no hidden cables or pipes in the wall. -This product has special protection against the ingress of moisture and is manufactured to meet IP44 standards. This product is suitable for use in Zone 2 and outside Zones of a bathroom. See diagram. It is recommended that the mirror is installed by a qualified electrician and is wired according to IET wiring regulations.



Cabinet Installation.

Measure distance A and B and mark the wall. Note the location of the hooks from the top of the cabinet and take this away from distance A. Allow extra space under the cabinet to suit the height of the tap to be installed.



Drill the required holes and insert the wall plugs. Using the fixings provided install the wall brackets and hang the cabinet on the wall brackets.





Mark the lower two fixing holes through the inside of the cabinet. Remove the cabinet, drill the holes and insert the wall plugs. Hang the cabinet again and secure to the wall.

Insert the shelf supports in the desired positions starting with the top shelf and place the shelves in. Fix the light unit to the top of the cabinet using the fixings provided.
